Our mission is to promote a healthy food system through the tradition of agriculture by providing a community gathering place for local farmers and artisans to sell their products. By bringing people together for a farmers market, we promote education, a greater sense of community and local business development.

The Community Farmers Market was incorporated as a Washington State non-profit in 2005 and we are entering our 15th season on Boistfort Street in Historic downtown Chehalis. Our Tuesday Farmers Market has grown steadily with the oversight of a small Board of Directors that consist of local farmers and community members. We have recently expanded to include a Friday evening market, bringing access to farm fresh products two days a week throughout the season. The Community Farmers Market at Chehalis provides opportunities for small businesses and farmers to share their goods in their community, while bringing the customers together to engage in a festive atmosphere with artisans and producers. We work towards making the market accessible and fun for a variety of customers by including weekly live music performances, cooking demonstrations, kids' club activities, and participating in WIC/Senior FMNP and SNAP programs.

# EBT Matching Program Sponsors Program Goal: \$2000

As an EBT Matching Program Sponsor, your contribution will match EBT customers' (Electronic Benefit Transfer, SNAP, or Food Stamp recipients) dollar for dollar, expanding food accessibility for low-income families in our community. There is no limit on the amount or availability of this sponsorship. Chehalis has very few points of access to locally grown, healthy foods. This doesn't sit right with us, especially since we live in a rich agricultural and ecological bioregion. Through matching programs like this, farmers get what they're work is worth and low income families get healthy food.

# Music Maker Program Goal: \$2000

As the Music Sponsor, your business or organization will provide funds to introduce weekly musical entertainment at the Market! These funds pay for electricity and equipment, payment of musicians, booking fees, and on site costs in specific regard to the music tent on Boistfort Street. Inviting musicians into the downtown region adds art, beauty, and creates a welcoming atmosphere. Aspiring local and young artists often get their start playing at farmers markets.

## Kid's Club Sponsor Program Goal \$2,000

As the Kid's Club Sponsor, your organization will provide funding for activity, crafting, art, and planting supplies for our Kids' Tent at the Tuesday afternoon market. Your money will also back the Kid's Tokens, which are distributed to participating children each week in \$2 increments for their purchase of fruits, flowers, and veggies at the market! We started this program in 2016, and from June 21 to August 31, we saw over 500 participants and handed out over \$1200 in Kid's Club tokens!

## Harvest Dinner Sponsor Goal \$4,000

As the Harvest Dinner Sponsor, your funds will purchase produce, protein, and other provisions for our Annual Harvest Dinner Celebration in October. This is our largest event and fundraiser of the season, and with your sponsorship, we will be able to compensate all of our local farmers and producers for the ingredients they have so graciously donated in the past. This is a huge move on behalf of The Market to bring our fundraising efforts directly back to the amazing vendors, who are the backbone of our organization.

#### Sponsorship Benefits:

Your promotional materials will be displayed at the info Booth, and during one market day throughout the season up to four employees (persons of choice) will receive bags containing \$5 in market tokens and other market goodies.

\$1000: The sponsors' logo will be featured on Farmers Market poster. Sponsors name will be mentioned four times in conjunction with affiliated program throughout the season worded as "this program is made possible with partners like…" Your promotional materials will be displayed at the market info booth. We will set up a 10x10 canopy for one market day during the season for your business or organization. You can decorate it and use it to interact with over 500 market customers.

\$1500: The sponsors' logo will be featured on Farmers Market poster. Sponsors name will be mentioned six times in conjunction with affiliated program throughout the season worded as "this program is brought to you by..." and a banner with your logo will hang in the program tent. Your promotional materials will be displayed at the market info booth. During one market day throughout the season up to four employees (persons of choice) will receive goodies bags containing \$10 in market tokens and other market goodies. We will set up a 10x10 canopy for one market day during the season for your business or organization. You can decorate it and use it to interact with over 500 market customers.
